Why is it important?

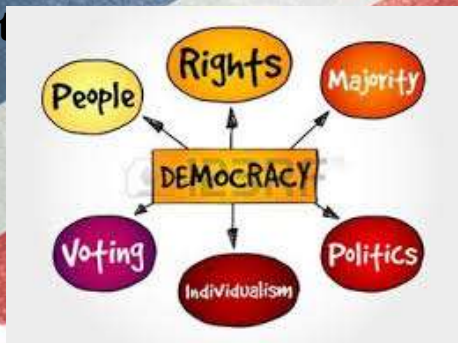
Democracy allows for decisions to be made by the public rather than being dictated to them.

Community Cohesion

What is Community Cohesion?
