English

We will be reading 'The Enormous Crocodile' in English. The children will produce a character description and a diary entry. To create these, we will be focusing on the following skills:

- Identifying features of different text types.
- Writing a description of a character.
- Developing expanded noun phrases.
- Exploring potential meanings of unfamiliar vocabulary.
- Summarising key points.
- Predict what might happen in a story using evidence.
- Use knowledge of the alphabet to locate words in a dictionary.
- Editing and redrafting our work using the schools marking code.
- Identifying the features of a diary entry.

Maths

In mathematics, we will be focusing this half-term on place value, addition and subtraction.

This term Year 2 children will learn to:

- Count in steps of 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.
- Compare and order numbers using <, > and = signs.
- Read and write numbers up to at least 100.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two digit number.
- Add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations and mentally.
- Show that the addition of two numbers can be done in any order and subtraction of one number from another cannot.

Please encourage your child to go over the 2, 5 and 10 times tables on a daily basis.

Science

In Science, Year 2 will be learning about different materials.

Children will be:

- Identifying and comparing the suitability of a variety of everyday materials.
- Identifying materials that objects are made from.
- Explaining the differences between an object and what it's made from.
- To ask questions about the uses of different materials.
- Describe the properties of objects.
- Describe the properties of a material.
- Suggesting different ways to carry out investigations.



Opportunities for SMSC

In Year 2 the children will:

- Learn about how their behaviour may effect how other people feel.
- In PSHCE children will be learning about individuality and what makes them special.
- In class discussions, children will learn how to be respectful and courteous when challenging each other's opinions.

Topic

In Topic, we will be learning about In art, the children will be drawing and Britain and where we are in relation to the rest of the world. Teaching will cover the following skills:

- Exploring the United Kingdom and understand what country and city they live in.
- Understanding location within the local area.
- Using aerial photographs and plan perspectives to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features.
- locational/directional Using language (near, far, left, right, north, south, east, west) to describe the location of features on a map.
- Talking about and describe the function of features and: landmarks within a locality
- Drawing simple maps of our area and use basic symbols in a key
- Talking about and comparing features of the local area
- Carrying out a small local survey, e.g. traffic, litter, land use

Art

painting their own portraits. They will learn to:

- Use crayons to create different textures.
- Identify different textures and patterns that they will use.
- Use sketching pencils to draw the first draft of their space shuttle.
- Use sketching pencils to outline the features of a face.
- Explore sketching techniques.
- Draw for a sustained period of time from the figure and real objects, including single and grouped objects.
- Experiment with the visual elements; line, shape, pattern and colour.
- Mix a range of primary colours.
- Experiment with tools and techniques.
- Name different types of paint.

Computing

In ICT, children will be learning how to keep safe online and will be introduced to the ICT Suite.

Children will be learning:

- How to be Safety SMART.
- How to log onto a computer.
- How to use a mouse to open programs.
- How to use the functions on a keyboard.

P.E.

In PE this term, we will be learning gymnastics and a variety of games. Children will be learning to:

- Move in different pathways in a range of ways through standing and using one or more of the feet and hands or whole body.
- Learn how to control a ball and develop the skills needed to successfully play a variety of ball games.

PSHCE

Our topic this term is about 'You and me'. During this topic children will:

- Learn the importance of feeling positive about themselves and others.
- Recognise positive and negative relationships.
- Think about others and appreciate the ways we are all similar and different.
- To be aware of the diversity of people around the world.
